

ORDINANCE 19-2024

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING
THE ADMINISTRATION TO ENTER INTO AN
NOAC ELECTRIC AGGREGATION CONSULTING
AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Delta has been part of the governmental aggregation for electric services since 2016, providing cost savings options to residential customers within the corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code and the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio require the renewal of the Village's licensure to participate in the program from time to time; and

WHEREAS, as part of this renewal, the Village engages Palmer Energy Company, Inc. to provide the necessary services for this program.

**THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF DELTA,
FULTON COUNTY OHIO THAT:**

Section 1. The Council for the Village of Delta hereby approves the NOAC Electric Aggregation Consulting Agreement with Palmer Energy Company, Inc., which Agreement is on file with the Village Administrator and the Village Administrator and administration are directed to execute the documents necessary to effectuate the Agreement.

Section 2. All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance and all deliberations of Council and any of its committees leading to such action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

Section 3. This ordinance is deemed an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is necessary in order to meet the mandated time requirements for submission to the PUCO.
