## **ORDINANCE 28-2024**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 181.013, ALLOCATION OF FUNDS, OF THE DELTA MUNICIPAL CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Delta has been advised that prior legislation identifying a distribution of municipal income tax funds needs to be corrected; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Delta amended Section 181.013 of the Delta Municipal Code on April 15, 2024 to reflect the a distribution of income tax to the water fund; and

WHEREAS In preparing the appropriations for fiscal year 2025, the Interim Village Administrator and the Finance Director find it necessary to recommend that Section 181.013 of the Delta Municipal Code allocation and distribution of municipal income tax funds be amended to reflect the needs of the Village's General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF DELTA, FULTON COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 181.013 of the codified ordinances of the Village of Delta, Fulton County, Ohio be amended to reflect the following distribution and allocation of income tax revenues:

## 181.013, ALLOCATION OF FUNDS

- (A) The funds collected under the provisions of this Chapter effective January 1, 2025, shall be applied and allocated as follows and for the following purposes:
- (1) Sixty-Six and two third percent (66 2/3%) to the General Fund for general operating expenses.
- (2) Thirty-three and one third percent (33 1/3 %) for the financing, construction, maintenance, operation, and improvement of the municipal waterworks system.

SECTION 2. All prior Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed effective January 1, 2025.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted at open meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with legal requirements as set forth by Village Charter.

<u>SECTION 4:</u> This ordinance is deemed an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare, and for the further reason that it is necessary to provide funds for the Village General Fund in Fiscal Year 2025.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance and allocation shall be effective no later than January, 2025.
