ORDINANCE 31-2024

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE EMPLOYMENT OF SAMUEL CHAPPELL AS POLICE CHIEF FOR THE VILLAGE OF DELTA AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN A CONTRACT TO EFFECTUATE THE AGREEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Delta finds that it would be in the best interests of the Village and its residents to employ Samuel Chappell as Police Chief for the Village; and

WHEREAS, Samuel Chappell has expressed a willingness to be employed in that position; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Delta and Samuel Chappell wish to enter into an employment agreement attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein in order to employ Samuel Chappell as such Police Chief.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF DELTA, FULTON COUNTY OHIO THAT:

Section 1. The Council for the Village of Delta hereby approves the employment contract with Samuel Chappell, attached hereto and further directs that the Mayor execute the contract effective December 16, 2024, on behalf of the Village.

<u>Section 2.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Delta and the State of Ohio.

<u>Section 3</u>. This ordinance is deemed an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is necessary to immediately provide police measures to ensure the safety of the inhabitants and visitors to of the Village.
