RESOLUTION 03-2025

AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CUSTOMER SUPPLY AGREEMENT FOR THE SUPPLY OF THIRD-PARTY ELECTRIC GENERATION AVAILABLE TO RESIDENTIAL AND SMALL COMMERCIAL AGGREGATION PARTICIPANTS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF DELTA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Delta, Ohio has been certified and authorized by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) as a governmental aggregator of electric power offering cost savings to residential and small commercial users choosing to participate in the Village program; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Delta is a member of the Northwest Ohio Aggregation Coalition (NOAC) along with fourteen (14) other communities; and

WHEREAS, the current agreement for electric supply for all NOAC communities with Energy Harbor expires May 2025, requiring Palmer Energy to request proposals from 6 firms, receiving proposals from 3 electric providers; and

WHEREAS, three proposals were received offering the best rates for all participating communities with the proposals being reviewed with Palmer Energy who recommends proceeding with the contract review and evaluation process with two providers being Dynegy and Constellation for a term of 12 months, which projected to provide annual savings of approximately \$9 for residential customers and \$18 for small commercial customers of the Villages aggregation program; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF DELTA, FULTON COUNTY, OHIO

Section 1. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a Customer Supply Agreement for electric power with Dynegy or Constellation, subject to final review and approval of NOAC Legal Counsel and the Village of Delta's energy consultant, Palmer Energy.

Section 2. That this Resolution was passed and all actions and deliberations of the Council relating thereto were conducted in meetings open to the public pursuant to Section 121.22 of the Ohio R.C.
Section 3. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage as an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, safety and welfare so as to provide uninterrupted and cost-effective electric service to all participants of the electric aggregation program of the Village of Delta
